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**FABRIC REQUIREMENTS & CUTTING GUIDE**

Finished Size: 51" x 63"

**Fabric A- Pete the Cat Panel – Multi** 9785-0119 1 panel  
Fussy cut six 9 1/2" x 10 1/2" blocks.

**Fabric B- Stripe – Multi** 9787-0120 5/8 yard  
Cut three 2 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into twelve 2 1/2" x 10 1/2" strips.  
Cut four 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into twelve 2" x 13 1/2" strips.

**Fabric C- Stars – Red** 9786-0111 1/2 yard  
Cut one 2 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into twelve 2 1/2" squares.  
Cut three 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut two 2" x 48 1/2" strips.  
Cut two 2" x 39 1/2" WOF strips.

**Fabric D- Pete Skateboarding – Orange** 9790-0128 1/3 yard  
Cut one 8 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into three 8 1/2" squares.

**Fabric E- Stars – Blue** 9786-0110 1/3 yard  
Cut three 2 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into twelve 2 1/2" x 8 1/2" strips.

**Fabric F- Stars – Yellow** 9786-0133 5/8 yard  
Cut one 2 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into twelve 2 1/2" squares.  
Cut six 2 1/2" x WOF strips for the binding.

**Fabric G- Stars – Green** 9786-0114 1/3 yard  
Cut three 2 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into twelve 2 1/2" x 8 1/2" strips.

**Fabric H- Logo – Yellow** 9788-0133 1/3 yard  
Cut one 8 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into three 8 1/2" squares.

**Fabric I- Patch – Multi** 9784-0150 1 1/2 yards  
Cut two 6 1/2" x 51 1/2" LOF strips.  
Cut two 6 1/2" x 51 1/2" WOF strips from the remaining fabric, piece as needed.

**Backing- Patch – Multi** 9784-0150 4 yards  
Cut two 71" x WOF strips. Sew together and trim to make one 59" x 71" back.

**Block Assembly**

Sew one 2 1/2" x 10 1/2" Fabric B strip to each side of one 9 1/2" x 10 1/2" Fabric A block.  
Sew one 2" x 13 1/2" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A block. Trim the block to measure 12 1/2" square to make (1) Block One (Fig. 1).  
Repeat to make six Block Ones total.

Sew one 2 1/2" x 8 1/2" Fabric E strip to each side of one 8 1/2" Fabric D square. Sew one 2 1/2" Fabric F square to each end of one 2 1/2" x 8 1/2" Fabric E strip. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew the strips to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric D square to make one Block Two (Fig. 2). Repeat to make three Block Twos total.

Sew one 2 1/2" x 8 1/2" Fabric G strip to each side of one 8 1/2" Fabric H square. Sew one 2 1/2" Fabric C square to each end of one 2 1/2" x 8 1/2" Fabric G strip. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew the strips to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric H square to make one Block Three (Fig. 3). Repeat to make three Block Threes total.

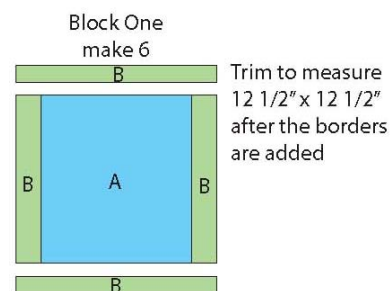

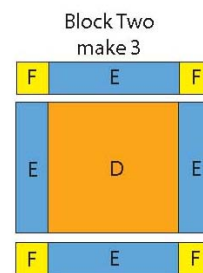

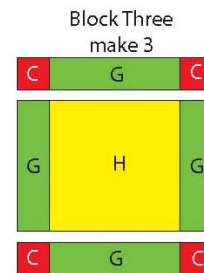

**Quilt Assembly** *(refer to the quilt layout while assembling the quilt top)*

Sew one Block One to each side of one Block Two to make Row One.

Sew one Block Three to each side of one Block One to make Row Two.

Sew one Block One to each side of one Block Three to make Row Three.

Sew one Block Two to each side of one Block One to make Row Four.

Sew the four rows together in numerical order to make the Center Block.

Sew one 2" x 48 1/2" Fabric C strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew one 2" x 39 1/2" Fabric C strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

Sew one 6 1/2" x 51 1/2" Fabric I strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew one 6 1/2" x 51 1/2" Fabric I strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

Layer and quilt as desired.

Sew the six 2 1/2" x WOF Fabric F strips together, end to end with 45° seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half, lengthwise with wrong sides together, and press.

Bind as desired.
